## Apple Mac OS Mojave+

- 1. Mac OS Mojave introduced the Screenshot application.
  - i. Open the Screenshot Application.
    - Press and hold Shift + Command.
    - Press the number 5 and then release all pressed keys.





- ii. Select the screen capture mode you wish to use.
  - Use  $\square$  to capture the entire screen.
  - Use to capture an application window.
  - Use to capture a portion of the screen.
  - Use a to record the entire screen.
  - Use to record a portion of the screen.
- iii. Click Capture.

Note: If you are using you must select the application you wish capture. If you are using you must drag a box around the area of your screen you wish to capture.

2. You may also use hotkeys (page 2) to capture screenshots.

## Apple Mac OS

- 1. Capture a screenshot of your entire screen.
  - i. Press and hold Shift + Command.
  - ii. Press the number 3 and then release all pressed keys.
  - iii. If your volume is audible you should hear a camera snapping.
- 2. Capture a screenshot of a portion of your screen.
  - i. Press and hold Shift + Command.
  - ii. Press the number 4 and then release all pressed keys.
  - iii. The cursor will change to a crosshair (+).
  - iv. Click and drag the cursor to create a box around the area of your screen you wish to capture.
  - v. If your volume is audible you should hear a camera snapping.
- 3. Capture a screenshot of a specific application.
  - i. Press and hold Shift + Command.
  - ii. Press the number 4 + the Space Bar.
  - iii. The cursor will change to a camera ( ).
  - iv. Click the window you wish to capture.
  - v. If your volume is audible you should hear a camera snapping.

Note: All captured screenshots will appear on your desktop with the name "Screen Shot [date] at [time].png.
