

# Webcam Recording

## Apple Mac OS Using Photo Booth

1. Mac OS now includes the Photo Booth application which can be used to take photos and videos using your computers attached web cam..

- i. Open the Photo Booth Application.

- Click on the launchpad [or] pinch three fingers inward on your trackpad.
- Open Photo Booth





- ii. Select the video capture mode.

- Locate the capture modes In the bottom left-hand corner of the Photo Booth application.
- Select the video capture mode.



- iii. Record Video

- Click  to begin recording.
- Click  to stop recording.

- iv. Export your video

- Locate the video you wish to save from your captured material.
- Control-click (or right click) the video and select export.
- Save the file in a location that will be easy to locate.


# Webcam Recording

## Apple Mac OS Using Quicktime


2. You can also create a webcam recording using Quicktime.



- i. Open Quicktime.
- ii. Click on the launchpad [or] pinch three fingers inward on your trackpad.

- Access the **Other** folder.
- Open Quicktime.



- iii. Click on **File > New Movie Recording** to launch the movie recording window.



- iv. Make sure your audio is turned all the way down and click the record your movie.
  - Click  to begin recording.
  - Click  to stop recording.
- v. When you click stop, a video of your recording will appear on your screen.
- vi. Save the video somewhere you can find it by clicking **File > Save As**.
